City Manager's Report: Mr. Potucek announced that the City's offices will be closed Thursday, July 4, 2024, in observance of Independence Day. He announced that the legislature adjourned without further impact to the city's revenues, which is good news. He announced that the city has received notification that the city did not get awarded the grant funds for Fry Boulevard. He also announced the work session on July 9, 2024, and Council Meeting of July 11, 2024, will be

cancelled. A special meeting has been scheduled for Monday, July 8th at 4pm in the council chambers to address the city acquisition of the Pueblo Del Sol Golf Course as Castle and Cooke has decided to leave the area. Since learning of the decision, no private buyers have been identified, so the city has been negotiating taking over the property. The city is looking into a contractual agreement with a management company to take over operations. The next regularly scheduled work session will be on July 23, 2023, at 3:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, followed by the regularly scheduled Council Meeting on July 25, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers.
