

- 1. Building Permits and Inspections Are Required For All Walls.
- 2. What to Submit for Permits:
  - a) A Site Plan Showing the Location of the Wall in Relation to the Lot Lines and Building.
- b) Provide Information Such as the Length and Height off the Wall and the Width of the Blocks used.
- 3. This Design is Not to be Used for Retaining Earth
- 4. Footings Should be Level, or if the Ground Slopes, Use Step Footings. Each Step Should be a Height to Fit Masonry System (4" min.). All Excavations Should be Contain no Loose Earth or Foreign Matter.
- 5. For Walls With Pilasters @ 10' O.C. Maximum, Place #4 Reinforcing Bar in Each Pilaster.
- 6. Cells Containing Reinforcement Shall be Filled Solidly with Grout, Grout Should be, One Part Cement, Three Parts Sand, and Two Parts Pea Gravel.
- 7. Mortar Mix: One Part Cement, !/2 Part Lime, and 4-1/2 Parts Sand.
- 8. All Walls on, or Within Property Lines, 6 Feet High and 3 Feet High Max. Within 20 Feet of the Front Property Line.
- 9. Pilasters Located at Gate Opening (>4 Ft.) May Require Additional Reinforcement to Support Weight of Gate.
- 10. Specific Additional Requirements Pertain to Swimming Pool Barriers.
