2. SOUTHCENTRAL DISTRICT REPORT

Jeremy Moore, ADOT SouthCentral Assistant District Engineer, will report on the status of current and potential ADOT projects within the region. This item is the time set aside for Board members to discuss issues, or raise questions, related to projects under ADOT's jurisdiction.

3. SIERRA VISTA PAVEMENT CONDITION SURVEY RESULTS

Megan Ratliff, Infrastrurure Management Services (IMS), will report on the results of the completed Sierra Vista area pavement condition survey. This data collection effort was funded by the SVMPO, and the results help the City prioritize their roadway maintenance needs. Board members will have the opportunity to ask questions about this completed data management tool.
