What is a Neighborhood Plan?

A neighborhood plan is a strategic guide developed to outline a community's vision for its future (re)development, growth, and improvement.

Plans are created through collaboration between residents, local government, and other stakeholders.

It addresses specific issues such as land use, transportation, housing, parks, public safety, economic development and community services.

The plan serves to preserve and enhance a neighborhood's character, improve quality of life, and guide future policies, investments, and zoning regulations, ensuring that changes align with community needs and aspirations.

Plan Initiation

- **Determine boundaries**
- **Clearly define scope, objectives, and goals of the planning process.**
- **Prepare schedule.**
- **Identify key stakeholders including residents, businesses, community organizations and other relevant parties.**
- **Establish a stakeholder engagement strategy to ensure diverse and inclusive participation.**

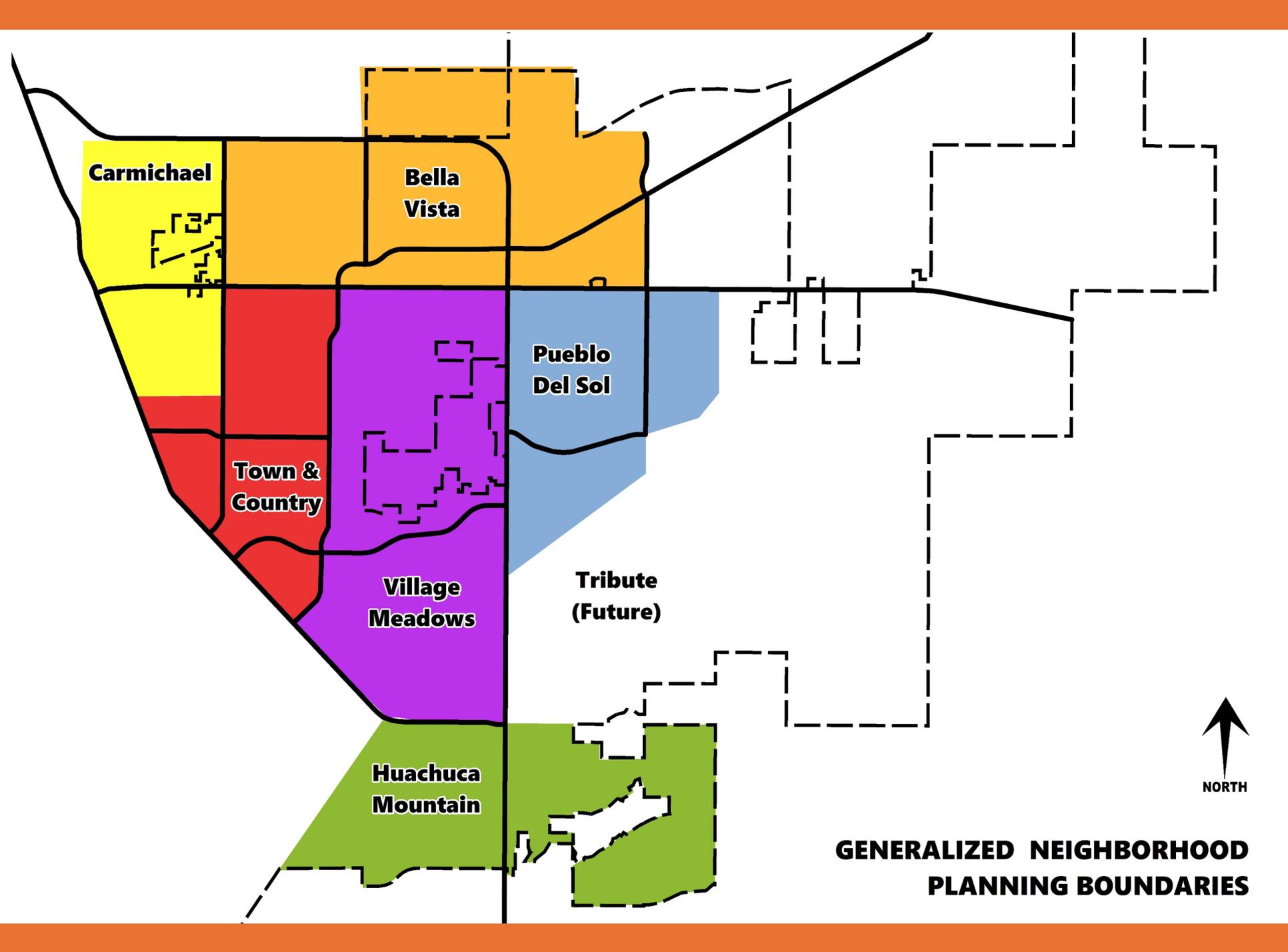

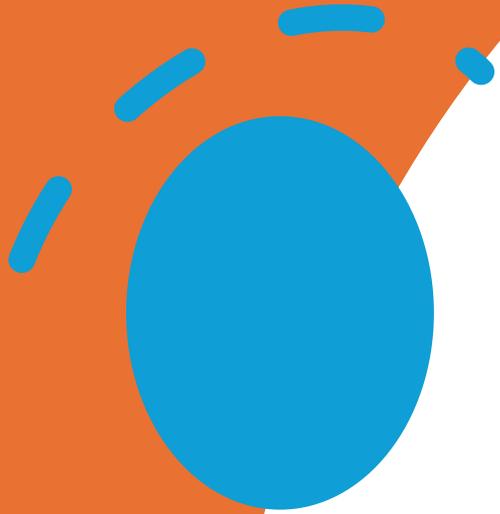

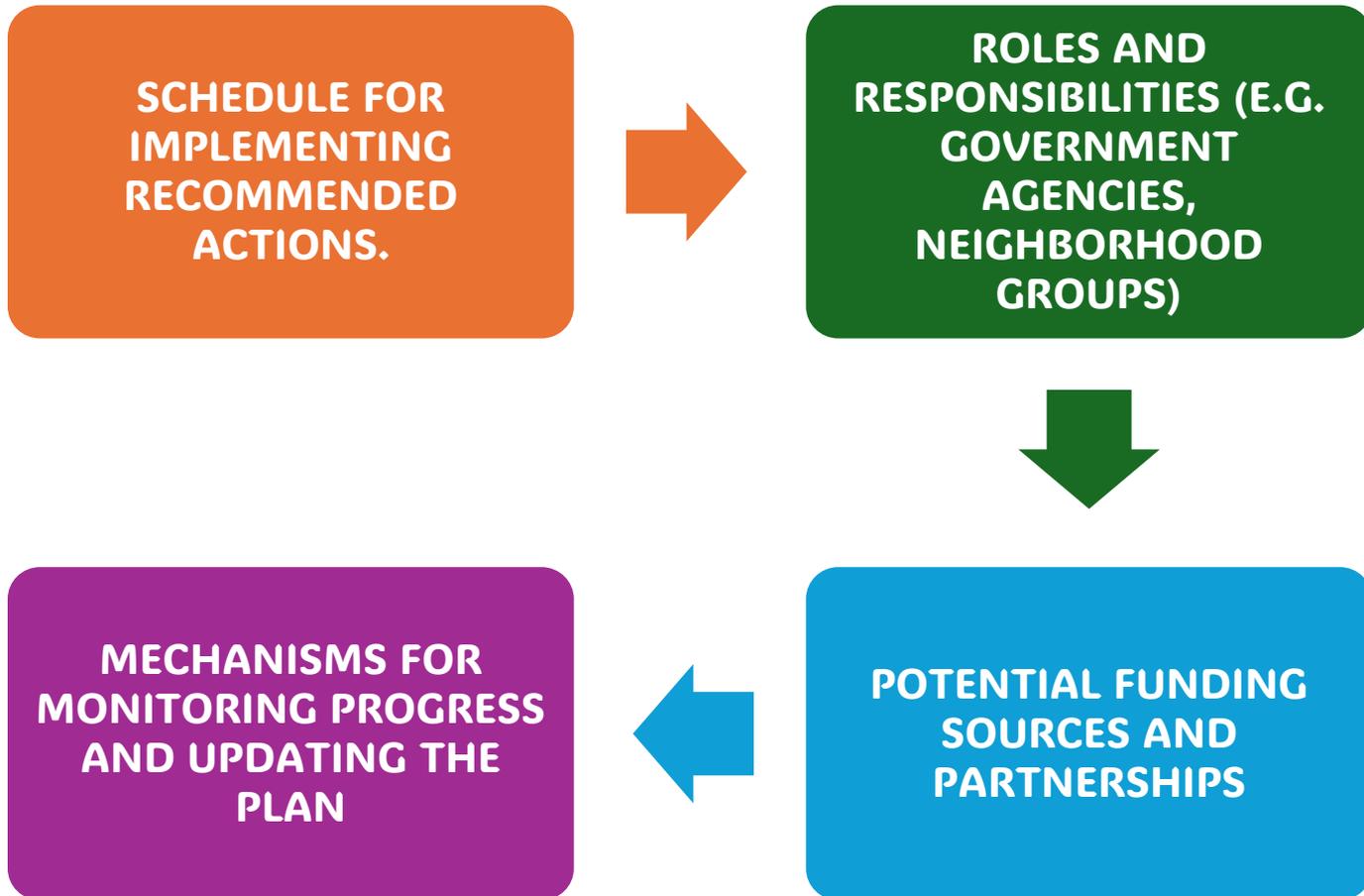
