- Monitor service to the public

Appointment:

- Recommended by City Manager
- Approved by City Council



Transportation Advisory Board (New)

Mission:

Advise the Director of Public Works on Transportation Issues

Structure:

- 5 Members
 - 1 Airport Representative
 - 1 Roads Representative
 - 1 Transit Representative
 - 1 Bicycle Representative
 - 1 Safe Routes to Schools Representative
- Staff Liaison: Public Works

Meets:

Quarterly (at a minimum)

Responsibilities:

Reviews Multi Modal Transportation Plans

Appointment:

- Recommended by City Manager
- Approved by City Council
