- •Transaction Privilege Tax increase \$3,133,087
- •VLT increase \$125,000
- •Sales Tax Increase increase \$1,359,466
- •Urban Revenue Sharing increase \$3,291,258
- •Fuel Sales increase \$53,500
- •Ambulance Fees increase \$300,000
